EXHIBITING ARTWORKS OVER DECEMBER & JANUARY IS FOR TWO MONTHS SO 2 MONTHS OF FEES AND ROSTERS APPLY

Each month is considered separately as a normal month so you must

- volunteer for roster duty for each month (2 rosters) and
- pay hanging fees for two months

Monthly fee for 1 painting is \$10, for 2 paintings it is \$15, so for the 2 months, December and January, the fees are double. For one painting for 2 months it costs \$20 and for 2 paintings for 2 months it costs \$30 to exhibit your work. If you cannot do roster duty you must pay \$25 for one month and for the two months, December and January, it is \$50.

HANGING FEES OVER DECEMBER AND JANUARY ARE \$20 FOR ONE PAINTING & \$30 FOR TWO PAINTINGS PLUS 2 DUTY ROSTER SHIFTS FOR THE TWO MONTHS

If you cannot do your roster duty then you must pay \$25. Thank you to ALL who fulfil their rostered shift.

She is excited to welcome **Natalie Popovski** as the replacement tutor for the watercolour classes re-commencing January 17. Natalie brings an array of art skills and experience in teaching art classes.

Annette is confident that students will have the chance to try new watercolour approaches, different styles and acquire fresh insights into their work. Below is more information about Natalie and examples of her artwork.

Natalie Popovski - Artist Statement

I have been teaching workshops in watercolour, oil paints, and drawing for over 5 years now and have had a range of students, from complete beginners to practicing artists and everything in between. I have a passion for teaching and love finding ways to distil abstract ideas of painting and drawing into teachable exercises that have us thinking and seeing differently.





My philosophy is a mix between classical techniques as well as an intuitive approach to painting. Specific to watercolour, I love both its ability to achieve detailed work with luminous colours, but also its watery and loose qualities that allow us to create dreamy impressions.

In 2021 I undertook intensive study under Rob Gutteridge at the Rob Gutteridge Atelier in Adelaide where I delved into the world of academic drawing and painting. I spent many hours drawing and painting from life, dissecting the methods of creating detailed form through the fall of light and shadow. I love weaving these classical techniques into my teachings as these are the foundations of painting. Mastering these methods will greatly enhance your ability to create realistic paintings, but also eventually aid you in learning

how to break these very same rules.

It will be tutored by Natalie Popovski in Annette's absence. Continuing students and potential new students please note that Annette Raff's Wednesday Watercolour Class will continue, restarting in the New Year from 17th January, tutored by Natalie Popovski till Annette Raff returns.


