

INSTRUCTIONS FOR HANGING PAINTINGS

When bringing in your paintings please ensure there are:

- 1. 'D-rings' and wire (or good cord) on the back for hanging.
- 2. (No screws or eyelets accepted)
- 3. Your name and phone number to be written or attached to the back.
- 4. Ensure canvases have clean or painted sides. If there is tape on the back, that it is fresh and not peeling off.
- 5. No old paintings over 8 years old to be submitted unless refreshed
- 6. No old scratched frames. We are a professional Gallery and would like to maintain a high standard.
- 7. The Consignment Form to be completed each month with the temporary label attached so we can match it with a new RQAS typed label. This can be done on the Saturday morning when bringing in your paintings for the month (9 am-12 pm) or you can print one off that is attached to the Newsletter to save time.
- 8. Please be aware that to be part of our Community Gallery, we are all volunteers and are required to take our turn at the front desk, once a month, to greet visitors, help with sales and enquiries they may have. You are the first person they turn to.
