From the vibrant colours of the Great Barrier Reef to the rugged outback, the serene beaches, and bustling cities, Australia offers a rich tapestry of inspiration for artists.

Through your artwork, we encouraged you to capture the essence of Australia – its people, its natural wonders, its heritage, and its spirit. Whether you are inspired by the majestic Uluru, the lively streets of Sydney, the tranquil countryside, or the cultural richness of Indigenous communities, you let your creativity flow and shared your interpretation of what makes Australia special. We look forward to seeing the gallery come alive with your vibrant and diverse representations of our beautiful country through the month of July.

As we admire the current exhibition, we also invite you to start preparing for next month's theme: "Collage and Mixed Media." This theme offers an exciting opportunity to experiment with different materials and techniques, pushing the boundaries of traditional art forms. Collage, a technique that involves assembling various elements such as paper, fabric, and found objects, originated in the early 20th century with artists like Pablo Picasso and Georges Braque. Mixed media expands on this by incorporating multiple mediums – such as paint, ink, and elements – into a single artwork, creating rich, textured pieces that tell complex visual stories.

The origin of collage and mixed media can be traced back to the Cubist movement, where artists sought to break away from conventional painting techniques and explore new ways of representing reality. This innovative approach has since evolved, allowing contemporary artists to experiment freely and combine diverse materials to create unique, multidimensional works of art.

I would like to take a moment to thank all our members for their continued support and active participation in our community. Your dedication and passion are the heartbeat of RQAS Broadbeach. The cut off date for filling in your online consignment label or sending QR code is the Wed before changeover days each month. You will receive the link by email each month to do it online. No hanging will be permitted without the online label completed. For assistance please ring Angela on 0415987111 or Belinda on 0409848360.

Attach to the back of your Paintings the following details:

- 1. Your name
- 2. Membership number (if you don't know this please ask the office)
- 3. Title of the painting
- 4. Your phone number

QR code is available from the front desk to take home. You just need to download any QR code reader from the App store of your choice.

The volunteers on changeover day will check to ensure you've got all you need to identify your work and that you have a roster shift date. These are important steps to streamline our processes






