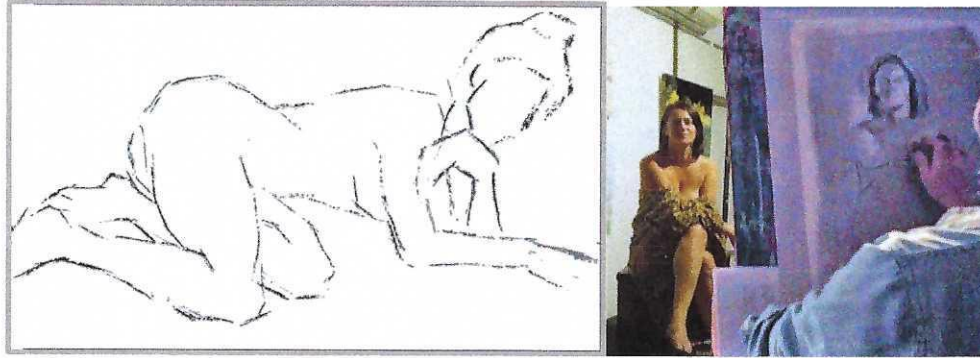


Life drawing foundations

- using line to describe the figure with sensitivity
- recognising space and the importance of interlocking shapes

Ree brings extensive knowledge and awareness of 'bodies' as a professional life model, yoga teacher and kinesiologist. With Annette's qualifications in fine art and design, extensive background as a popular art teacher, knowledge of a variety of medium and concepts, and foundational drawing skills, Annette believes that drawing is really a matter of learning to 'see'. You will practise strategies to un-block habits hindering your ability to see what is really there as opposed to what you think you see.
